



THE DOGMA OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

"I will put enmities between thee and the woman." In these words the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary was announced to our first parents. It was to be the reversal of the friendship with the serpent contracted by Eve, when she listened to his voice and fell under his power. The second Eve was never to be under the power of the Devil; the enmity between them was to admit of no possible exception. This involved the grace of being conceived immaculate. Mary's Immaculate Conception was the foundation of all her graces. The absence of any stain or spot of sin distinguished her from all the rest of mankind. It distinguished her from the holiest of the Saints, since they, one and all, were sinners. Her perfect sinlessness was the source of all her glory and all her majesty; it was this which opened the door to the unlimited graces that she received from God; it was this that qualified her for her Divine Maternity, and raised her to the throne as Queen of Heaven.

ROMAN STATIONAL CHURCH SECOND SUNDAY IN THE ADVENT OF THE LORD: CHURCH OF THE HOLY CROSS-AT-JERUSALEM



"In Palestine Christians gather today in Jerusalem for the celebration of holy Mass. In Rome they proceed to the stational church 'Holy Cross at Jerusalem' which serves to give the atmosphere of

the Holy City...Already

now the Church sings of the [heavenly] Jerusalem. For during Advent we await the Savior who will appear on the Last Day to take all into the 'new Jerusalem coming down from heaven'...On Epiphany, the climax to the current season, the Church will cry out: Arise, shine, O Jerusalem, for the glory of the Lord has risen upon thee...Today we must prepare for the great King's visit to the city [of our soul]. The whole coming week must be devoted to it. The Church prays: Awaken our hearts to prepare the way for Your Only-Begotten Son that we may serve Him with purified hearts."





LATIN MASS PROPERS: THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

INTROIT: Introit (Isaias 61:10) I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, and my soul shall be joyful in my God: for He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, and with the robe of justice He hath covered me, as a bride adorned with her jewels. Psalm. I will extol Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast upheld me: and hast not made my enemies to rejoice over me. \tilde{V} . Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — I will greatly rejoice ...

COLLECT O God, who, by the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin, didst prepare for Thy Son a worthy habitation, we beseech Thee, that as Thou didst preserve her from every stain by the foreseen death of this Thy Son, so Thou wouldst grant that we also being cleansed from guilt by her intercession, may come to Thee. Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord, Who with Thee liveth and reigneth in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.

EPISTLE: Proverbs 8. 22-35 The Lord possessed me in the beginning of His ways, before He made anything, from the beginning. I was set up from eternity, and of old, before the earth was made. The depths were not as yet, and I was already conceived; neither had the fountains of waters as yet sprung out; the mountains with their huge bulk had not as yet been established: before the hills I was brought forth; He had not yet made the earth, nor the rivers, nor the poles of the world. When He prepared the heavens, I was there; when with a certain law and compass He enclosed the depths; when He established the sky above, and poised the fountains of waters; when He compassed the sea with its bounds, and set a law to the waters that they should not pass their limits; when He balanced the foundations of the earth; I was with Him, forming all things, and was delighted every day, playing before Him at all times, playing in the world: and my delight is to be with the children of men. Now therefore, ye children, hear me: blessed are they that keep my ways. Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed is the man that heareth me, and that watcheth daily at my gates, and waiteth at the posts of my doors. He that shall find me shall find life, and shall have salvation from the Lord.




