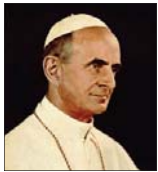

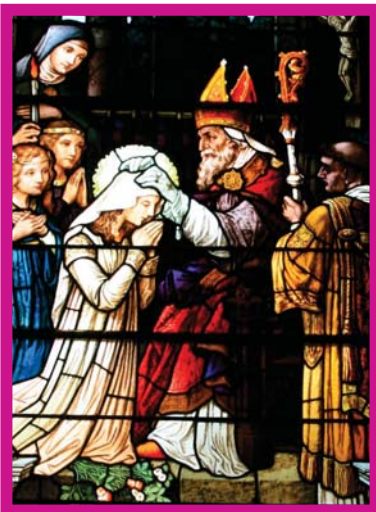


ABOVE: *Christ and the Centurion*, by Paolo Veronese.

**COLLECT:** O almighty and everlasting God, look mercifully upon our weakness: and stretch forth the right hand of Thy Majesty to protect us. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son ...

**EPISTLE:** From Blessed Paul the Apostle to the Romans, 12. 16-21 Brethren: Be not wise in your own conceits. To no man rendering evil for evil: providing good things, not only in the sight of God, but also in the sight of all men. If it be possible, as much as is in you, have peace with all men. Revenge not yourselves, my dearly beloved, but give place unto wrath, for it is written: Revenge is mine: I will repay, saith the Lord. But if thine enemy be hungry, give him to eat: if he thirst, give him to drink: for doing this, thou shalt heap coals of fire upon his head. Be not overcome by evil, but overcome evil by good.

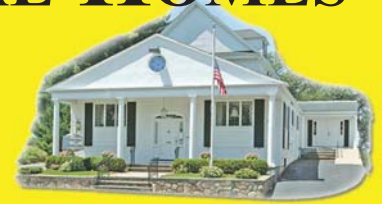

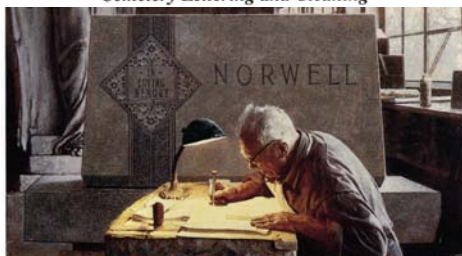
